Aesthetic Sculpting of Composite Resin Anterior and Posterior Course

Day 1: Lecture Program

The discovery of composite resin has allowed the Dentist to aesthetically restore diseased and defective anterior and posterior teeth.

Beyond the general use of composite resin for minor restorative procedures, there is a growing need to provide cost and tooth saving options for the patient's who require aesthetic changes to their dentition to enhance the look of their teeth.

This lecture will focus on aspects related to delivering free-handed composite resin bonded restorations for both anterior and posterior teeth.

The following areas will be discussed:

Anterior teeth:

- The hows and whys of fabricating aesthetic composite veneers
- Smile design
- Selecting composite shades
- Masking discolouration
- Achieving natural tooth forms
- Techniques of creating tertiary anatomy
- Choosing the correct hand instruments to use
- Finishing and polishing of composite
- Maintenance issues to provide longer lasting restorations

Posterior teeth:

- How to select colour for posterior teeth
- How to create anatomical restorations
- Instruments that make the task easier
- Tooth preparation, composite build up techniques
- Understanding the bonding process
- How to avoid post-operative sensitivity

At the completion of the lecture, the participant will have gained a thorough understanding of the use of composite resin for aesthetic corrections. Greater confidence will pave the way for the improved delivery of these types of restorations to patients.

Posterior teeth:

The participants will be instructed on how to produce an aesthetic class I composite restoration on a molar in the typodont, employing the techniques covered in the lecture, such as:

- Cavity preparation
- Bonding
- Shade selection
- Composite cuspal layering
- Adjusting and polishing the final restoration

Anterior teeth:

Achieving symmetry of both central incisors is the fundamental key in delivering aesthetic smiles. The goal of the anterior hands-on component is to work on both central incisors (one discoloured and the other fractured) of the typodont and obtain perfect symmetry.

A wax up procedure will also be carried out on the fractured tooth, to enable a matrix key to be constructed. The key learning points include:

- Wax up of tooth on a plaster model
- Fabrication of polyvinyl siloxane key/matrix
- Tooth preparation
- Shade selection
- Anatomical shaping of composite resin
- Polishing and finishing to achieve a high lustre

Dr. Terry Wong lectures internationally on the topic of composite resin restorations. Presently, Dr. Wong lectures at Melbourne University and La Trobe University in Bendigo on the topic of Aesthetic Dentistry and conducts handson programs about free handed delivery of composite restorations.

He attended the Las Vegas Institute and studied occlusion at the Kois centre in Seattle. He has been personally instructed by Dr. Newton Fahl of the Fahl School of Art and Science in Aesthetic Dentistry in Brazil. Dr. Wong obtained his degree at Melbourne University in 1987 and maintains a general practice in Melbourne with emphasis on restorative dentistry.
